St. Louis in July is hot and humid, with temperatures typically ranging from the mid-70s to the mid-90s°F (24-35°C). Expect high humidity and occasional thunderstorms.

METROBUS & METROLINK

The MetroBus fleet consists of nearly 400 buses operating 75 bus routes. Many MetroBus routes connect to MetroLink stations. Go to www.metrostlouis.org to view a description of how Metro can connect you with many great attractions in the St. Louis area.

MetroLink is the St. Louis metropolitan region's light rail system, connecting 46 miles of rail across 38 MetroLink stations in Missouri and Illinois. MetroLink trains operate seven days a week from before 5 a.m. to about 1 a.m. each day.

Fares can be purchased in advance and activated upon boarding the train/bus. If an attendee wanted to purchase a paper ticket, there are ticket vending machines at each of the MetroLink stations to purchase fare media. Lastly, if a bulk order is needed, contact the Passenger Revenue Pass Department (314) 982-1400 EXT 2551. Metro staff would be able to service any fare media purchase as well.

DRIVING

Downtown St. Louis is a square grid pattern, with north/south streets generally numbered from the river westward. (Exceptions are Broadway, which is 5th Street, and Tucker, which is 12th Street.) Most streets are one way and alternate directions every other street. Rush hour is 7-9 a.m. and 4-6 p.m. East-west street addresses correspond to north-south cross streets (e.g. 600 Olive is at 6th and Olive).

WALKING

Many downtown attractions such as the Gateway Arch, Soldiers Memorial Military Museum, Citygarden, Union Station and the Old Courthouse are also within eight to ten blocks of the Convention Center.

PARKING

Abundant parking is available in high-rise garages and on surface lots throughout downtown.

Parking meters are available on the streets and generally have a two-hour time limit that is strictly enforced. Parking at most meters in the City of St. Louis is free after 7 p.m., Monday-Saturday, and all day on Sunday.

personal safety

The St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department encourages visitors and residents to observe the following safety suggestions:

- Pay close attention to your surroundings.
- Carry as few items as possible.
- Avoid shortcuts that take you through alleys, gangways, and other unlit, isolated areas.
- Carry a small amount of cash, and only the credit cards that you intend to use.
- Make sure belongings in your car are properly stored away from view.
- Park at one of 15 Preferred Downtown Parking Facilities that meet both the security and service standards our guests expect.
- Panhandling is illegal in St. Louis. Do not encourage or reward panhandling.
- Call or text (314) 280-4817 to request a safety officer to walk with you to your destination.

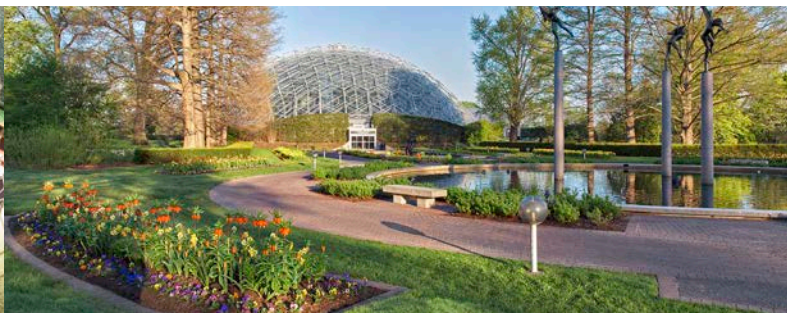

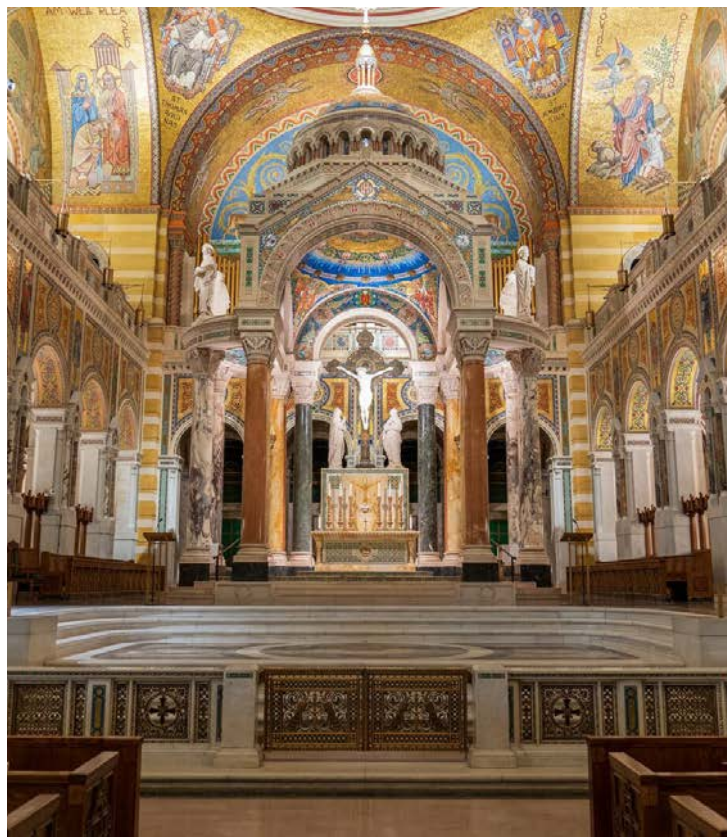
